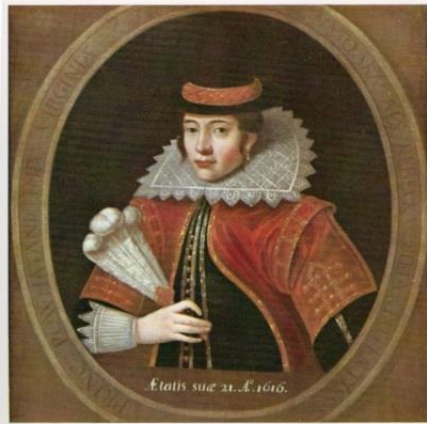


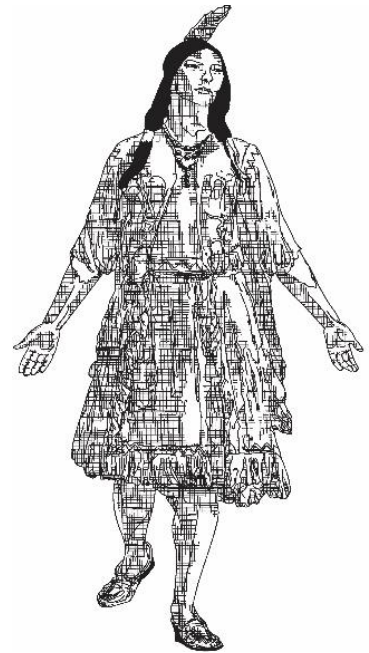
'Pocahontas and the Percys'
